9. Steer/Heifer can only be entered in (1) class, except showmanship.
10. All animals shown in purebred classes are to be registered in the exhibitor's name.
11. All cattle are required to have health papers at the time of registration.
12. Generator power is encouraged.

3. Hogs may arrive started at 6 a.m., with registration open until 8:30 a.m.
4. All pigs must be born after December 1, 2017
5. Exhibitors are encouraged to show off trailers, but will have pens available. No straw for bedding.
6. All pens must be cleaned by exhibitor before leaving the fairgrounds.
7. All pigs must be registered stock, except crossbreds.
8. All animals shown in purebred classes are to be registered in the exhibitor's name
9. All swine must be accompanied by official Health Certificate or test report.
10. Must declare own weight on barrows and cross gilts. No weigh back, will use the honor system
11. Superintendent has right to change classes day of show depending on entries
12. The top 5 in each class will be placed.
13. Premiums for gilts and barrows will be determined after all entries are made
14. Superintendent's decisions are final
15. **Not responsible for accidents.**
